Comrades:

As an update to the discussion with NSLC surrounding Poppy Campaign please be referred to the points provided by NSLC below.

- The NSLC will accept the RCL's Poppy donation boxes which can remain in stores for the duration of the Poppy Campaign, in a location determined by the local store manager. A contact name must be left with the donation boxes so that the store can contact the local legion should the box need to be replenished or have any additional questions.
- The local legion should contact the local NSLC store manager a minimum of 4 weeks in advance to coordinate details of the poppy campaign.
- The local legions may set-up tables and sell poppy related items during the time period of the campaign. These tables must be manned by a member of the legion and are set-up/taken down by the legion members upon arrival/departure.
- This arrangement is one of collaboration and in respect for the service provided by the Royal Canadian Legion and its members. However, please note that the NSLC does not accept any liability related to the possession of the donation boxes during the poppy campaign.
