#### SUBJECT: POSTER & LITERARY CONTEST 2022 – DEADLINE & GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Comrades:

The deadline for the 2022 Poster & Literary Contest entries to reach Command will be **Monday, January 9, 2023**.

Please be reminded that submissions **<u>must reach Command</u>** no later than that date to be included in the Command judging process.

The following instructions must also be followed by all participating Branches:

- 1. Each entry **MUST BE** accompanied by a thoroughly completed RCL Annual Poster & Literary Remembrance Contest Registration Form (copy enclosed).
- 2. The Registration Form must include the **Zone, Branch No., student name/home phone number/address, school name/address as well as the Student Consent** (if student is over 16 years old) **or Guardians Permission** (if student is under 16 years of age).
- 3. Only **two (2) entries per category** may be entered by a Branch.
- 4. Literary entries:
  - Senior a composition in prose of not more than 800 words or a poem of not more than 32 lines
  - Intermediate 500 words or a poem of not more than 32 lines
  - Junior 350 words or a poem of not more than 32 lines
- 5. Poster entries:
  - Candidates must be reminded that entries will be no larger than 56cm X 71cm
  - Colour posters may use full colour
  - B&W must be in pencil, charcoal and/or India Ink
- 6. The form **Poster & Literary Contest Statistics** (copy enclosed) must be completed and submitted with the entries package.
