Dear Mr. Flannigan:

The Government of Canada is planning an overseas event to mark the 75th anniversary of The Dieppe Raid. An official Government of Canada delegation will be travelling from August 16 to 21, 2017, to attend remembrance ceremonies and events at a number of sites in northern France.

On behalf of Veterans Affairs Canada, I would be pleased if you could nominate one Canadian war Veteran to join the Government of Canada delegation to represent The Royal Canadian Legion. It is recommended that the Veteran have a connection to the Dieppe Raid or the Second World War. A nomination form is enclosed.

Criteria to consider when selecting the Veteran include the comfort of the Veteran in sharing his or her military experiences and the Veteran's ability to make informal presentations about his or her experiences to members of the delegation and the public. In addition, the Veteran must be physically capable of making the trip.

If the Veteran is over 80 years of age or has a medical condition that requires help with daily living requirements, the nominee is encouraged to choose a caregiver who can assist with such things as getting in and out of the bath/shower, administering medication, pushing wheelchairs, etc. Each Veteran and his or her caregiver will be expected to share a room. Additional details regarding the role of the caregiver will be provided to the nominated Veteran.





Although a medical officer will accompany the delegation, the busy schedule of events requires that all members of the delegation be in good health. Nominees will be asked to have their family physician certify that they are in good health and that they are able to withstand the fatigue of extended travel.
