70th NS/NU Command Legion Curling Association Bonspiel 2018

The 2018 Association Bonspiel will take place at Hants County Br #09, 35 Empire Lane, Windsor NS, 902-798-2031 and Windsor Curling Club, 174 Gray St, Windsor NS, 902-798-4662 from 19 to 22 Jan 2018. The Legion Curling Association Executive Meeting will take place at 2pm followed by the General Meeting at 3pm on 19 Jan at Br 09.

Entries will be limited to twenty-four (24) teams. Registration will be as follows:

All branches may enter any number of teams marked number 1, number 2, number 3, etc. The first 24 number 1 teams will be entered in the draw and if 24 teams are not realized, the draw will be filled by the remaining teams based on the date of arrival of entries received by the Secretary/Treasurer of the Legion Curling Association.

Entry fee is \$200 per four player team and must accompany the team entry. A team may enter up to six players. An additional fee of \$15 for all spares or curler guests (wife, etc.) must be sent with the entry form to cover the banquet. Applications must reach the Secretary/Treasurer by 12 Jan 2018 to give organizers time to make up a draw, order food, etc.

Entries on the enclosed form must be sent to Pete Comeau, PO Box 195, Weymouth, NS, B0W 3T0 prior to 12 Jan 2018. Teams must report in person or by phone to Windsor Br #09 on or before 5pm 19 Jan 2018. Any team not reporting by that time will be scratched and no entry fee will be refunded.

Play will start on Friday, 19 Jan 2018 at 6pm and all games will be eight (8) ends in a double knock-out competition.

A draw will be made for the teams that lose their first two games; every team is guaranteed at least three (3) games. Teams may be required to play three (3) games in one day because of ice times allotted to the Legion Branch.

The Annual Meeting of the Legion Curling Association will be held at 3pm on Friday 19 Jan 2018 at Legion Br #09 and registration will be there from 1pm till 5pm in the Sports Room of Br #09. The draw will be made after the Annual General Meeting at the branch.

The Banquet will be held at Windsor Br #09 at 7pm on Saturday 20 Jan 2018.

Also enclosed is a list of available accommodations in the Windsor area and the rates.

Any Branch wishing to host the 2019 bonspiel must have the invitation in writing and signed by the Branch Secretary or President and in the hands of the Association Committee prior to the Annual General Meeting.

All curlers must be a member in good standing of a Branch and in possession of a current membership card to present at time of registration. Members of more than one small Branch may form a team if no other options are available.
