Subject: NS/NU Command Dart Championships - 2019 (Bedford Branch #95)

Comrades:

This is to inform all concerned of the dates for the NS/NU Command Dart Championships March 9-10, 2019 in Bedford Branch 95 which leads to the Dominion Dart Championships, which will take place in Dominion, NS, Branch #78 May 3 - 6, 2019.

The dates will be: Saturday, March 9, 2019 for Singles and Doubles Play and Sunday March 10, 2019 for Teams. Doubles starts at 8:30 am on Saturday followed by Singles (no earlier than 1 pm).

Captain's meeting will be Sunday at 8:30 a.m. sharp. Play will start at 9:00 a.m. at Bedford Branch No. 95, Bedford, which is the site of the Championships. For qualification, refer to the latest Sports Guide.

Teams absent from the Captain's meeting will be disqualified from play, unless the NS/NU Command Darts Secretary is otherwise notified. As moved, seconded and voted on at the Captain's meeting any teams not showing up at the Provincial Level without informing the NS/NU Command Darts Secretary will have a 1 year suspension from playing NS/NU Command Darts.

Each Branch may enter up to three [3] teams; three [3] Doubles and three [3] Singles for Zone Play. **Each Zone** may send two [2] teams, doubles and singles to the Provincials. **Branches are responsible for their team's eligibility.**

The winning team, double and single Champions will proceed to the **Dominion Darts Championships in Dominion, NS.** Winners make their own travel plans through a specific travel agent.

Cost of Registration at the Zone level will be:

Team - \$60.00Doubles - \$40.00Singles - \$25.00for each team entered from your Branches for Zone Playoffs.

Zone Commanders will be responsible for the operation of Zone Shoots.

All monies collected at the Zone level must be sent to the undersigned with all the information on the enclosed forms by **March 1, 2019.**

NS/NU Command Dart Information

The 2019 NS/NU Command Dart Championships will be held at Bedford Branch 095, Bedford, N.S. The Doubles will start at 8:30 am on Saturday March 9, 2019. Singles play will be immediately after the doubles finishes on Saturday (no earlier than 1 pm). The Teams Captain's meeting will be at 8:30 am sharp on Sunday, March 10, 2019 with play to start immediately following the meeting.

Any team absent from the captain's meetings will be disqualified from play that day, unless the NS/NU Secretary is otherwise notified. Any teams not showing up at the Provincial Level without informing the NS/NU Command Darts Secretary will have a 1 year suspension from playing NS/NU Command Darts.

Canteen service will be provided Saturday and Sunday at the Legion.

HOST BRANCH RESPONSIBILITIES




- 1. Any Branch in Nova Scotia/Nunavut Command wishing to host the Provincial Darts Championship will make application to the Dart Committee **3 years prior** to the intended date. Rotation Mainland 3 years and Cape Breton 1 year in every 4 years.
- 2. Branches should have adequate **accommodation** in club rooms for at least 100 people.
- 3. Ten [10] **regulation darts boards** with suitable lighting to be available **plus** 2 practice boards separate from the playing boards. Also, **chalk and scoreboards, plus 1 large scoreboard** for point standing.

A **one inch marker** is to be placed at the 9' 7 1/4" mark to eliminate the line being trodden on by other players.

- 4. The **Dart Committee** will be responsible for supplying the chief referees plus additional personnel for the operation of the shoot.
- 5. Food will be available at the Branch by 11 a.m. and sold at the regular Branch prices during the duration of the shoot. **There will be no stoppage of play for meals.** The same for Sunday.
- 6. The sum of \$200.00 will be allotted to the host Branch by the Dart Committee for Branch costs.
- 7. A **list of hotel/motel accommodations** available and approximate costs will be supplied to the Dart Committee by the first week of **September** in the year **preceding** the championships.
- 8. Host Branch shall apply to have the bar open for the beginning of the shoot, Saturday at 8:30 am and Sunday at 9 am.
- 9. NS/NU Command Darts has a no cancellation policy for the championship tournament.

The above guidelines for host Branches were approved at the Captains' Meeting held at Louisbourg Br.062, Louisbourg, NS during the 2018 Championships.

Note: This dart shoot is always held the second week-end in March unless Easter falls on that week-end.
