SUBJECT: POSTER & LITERARY CONTEST 2021 - DEADLINE & GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Comrades:

The deadline for the 2021 Poster & Literary Contest entries to reach Command will be **Friday, January 7, 2022**.

Please be reminded that submissions **<u>must reach Command</u>** no later than that date to be included in the Command judging process.

The following instructions must also be followed by all participating Branches:

- 1. Each entry **MUST BE** accompanied by a thoroughly completed RCL Annual Poster & Literary Remembrance Contest Registration Form (copy enclosed).
- 2. The Registration Form must include the **Zone**, **Branch No.**, **student name/home phone number/address**, **school name/address as well as the Student Consent** (if student is over 16 years old) or **Guardians Permission** (if student is under 16 years of age).
- 3. Only **two (2) entries per category** may be entered by a Branch.

4. Literary entries:

- <u>Senior</u> a composition in prose of not more than 800 words or a poem of not more than 32 lines
- Intermediate 500 words or a poem of not more than 32 lines
- Junior 350 words or a poem of not more than 32 lines

5. Poster entries:

- Candidates must be reminded that entries will be no larger than 56cm X 71cm.
- Color posters may use full Colour.
- B&W must be in pencil, charcoal and/or India Ink.
- 6. The form **Poster & Literary Contest Statistics** (copy enclosed) must be completed and submitted with the entries package.

The Royal Canadian Legion Poster & Literary Contest is one of the most enduring and successful programs The Legion offers thanks to the commitment, cooperation, and the many hours of work by our members at all levels.

Annual Poster and Literary Contests Judging Guidelines



POSTER CONTEST REGULATIONS

- This contest is open to all Canadian students in 1. the Canadian school system.
- All entries are to be submitted to the local 2. Legion branch.
- Students who have been out of the educational 3. system for more than two consecutive years are ineligible to compete in the Poster Contest at any level.
- Entries will be no larger than 56 cm x 71 cm. 4.
- Please choose which contest you would like to 5. enter and use only the following:

Black & White: Pencil, charcoal and/or India ink

- Entries will be judged on originality, expression 6. of designated subject, drawing and illustration. COMPUTER GENERATED ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- The poster shall reflect **REMEMBRANCE** with a 7. Canadian theme. If symbols are used, Canadian symbols shall be pre-eminent. Such national symbols are Canadian and provincial flags, coats of arms, and representative flowers, birds or animals, as well as all forms of Canadian historical and current military dress.
- Candidates will complete an official Registration 8. Form, available from the local Legion branch or online at www.Legion.ca. Attach it to the entry (no staples please).
- Winning posters, at the national level, will be 9. framed and placed on display at the Canadian War Museum in Ottawa for one year. Second and third place national level winners will be displayed at Parliament Hill during the week of Remembrance. All artwork will be returned to the artists through Provincial Commands.
- 10. A Contestant may enter both the Colour Contest and the Black and White Contest, but may submit only one entry for each category.

LITERARY CONTEST REGULATIONS

- This contest is open to all Canadian students in the Canadian school system.
- 2. All entries are to be submitted to the local Legion branch.
- Students who have been out of the educational system for more than two consecutive years are ineligible to compete in the Literary Contest at any level.
- Entries may be submitted in either English or French.
- Entries will be marked on the basis of originality of thought, expression, presentation, grammar, spelling and Canadian content.
- Candidates will complete an official Registration Form, available from the local Legion branch or online at www.Legion.ca. Attach it to the entry.
- 7. Candidates will use only one side of the page.
- Entries must not exceed the word or line limit as outlined on the entry form.
- A Contestant may submit both an Essay and a Poem but may submit only one entry for each category.

Clarity of Language 15% Is the language simple, direct? Is it expressed logically?		
Composition 15%	Are the basic rules of syntax observed? Are the basic rules of punctuation followed? Is the spelling correct?

Clarity 15%	Is the message clear?	
Pace 15%	Is the pace consistent? Is it dull?	
Rhythm 15%	Is the rhythm of words appropriate? Is it natural? Is it exciting?
