- Please ensure that all poster and literary entries are on the new forms as **entries on old forms will not be accepted**. Fillable forms are available online at the links provided above. Printed forms (200832) are listed on the Poppy Promotional Order Form and are available from supply at NS/NU Command.
- A poster has been developed that has a QR code that can be scanned and downloaded with the contest details as well as a space at the bottom for Branches to fill in their information. [Contest Poster](#)
- A video contest has been added and is open to entries at both the Senior and Intermediate level. Videos must be submitted directly to the Dominion Command link. The video entry form must be completed online only. <https://www.remembrancecontests.ca/>
- Poster entries on canvas or other material will not be accepted by Dominion Command. The rules now state "*Entries must be submitted on paper or Bristol Board. Entries on other materials such as canvas, or photo paper, or made of craft material such as foam, textiles or wood will not be accepted.*"

Please note that poster and literary submissions must reach NS/NU Command no later than Monday January 8, 2024 to be included in the Command judging process. Only 2 entries per category may be entered by a Branch.
