Nova Scotia / Nunavut Command Legion 8-Ball 2018 Championships

- The Nova Scotia / Nunavut Command Legion 2018 8-Ball Championships will be held at Bridgewater Legion Br# 24 on March 17 – 18, 2018.
- The winners of the NS/NU Command Legion 2018 8-Ball Championships will advance to the Dominion Command 8-Ball Championships to be held at Branch # 060 located at 1317 - 4 Street, Estevan, SK, S4A 0X1 from May 25 -28, 2018.
 - The NS/NU Command 8-ball 2018 tournament will be accepting up to ten (10) teams.
 - The tournament format will be the same as last year, with the option to change to a similar format used by Dominion Command. The format will be discussed and voted on at the captain's meeting. Both scoring formats will be ready so neither will delay start of the games except to explain to the participants. Here is what the second option would be:
 - The teams will consist of 4 players broken down into two pairs and all players must be members in good standing of the Royal Canadian Legion. (Dominion Sports Guide Sec.
 - The tournament format will be based on four divisions in two conferences. Each member team will be placed in a separate division. Both members of the respective doubles pairs will be placed in the same conference.
 - The two 2-man teams that score the highest will make up the Provincial Team that will move on to the Nationals to represent NS/NU Command.
 - The Provincial trophy will be awarded to the 2-man team that scored the highest.
 - All Zone and District teams that have qualified through a Zone or District 8-Ball tournament and are verified by their Zone / District Commander will be accepted. If ten teams are not realized the draw will be filled by the remaining entries based on the date the entries were received by the 8-Ball Chairperson. Teams must be registered by March 2nd, 2018. If more than 10 teams are registered those that do not make the draw will be notified by the 8-Ball Chairperson.
 - The number of games played will be determined by the number of team entries.
 - Play will be standard 8-Ball as per the WPA (ball in hand) rules.
 - The entry fee for this tournament will be \$200.00.
 - The Captain's meeting will be on March 17 at 9:00AM with play to start immediately following the
