Centenary Parade and Reception

Good day comrades, our Centenary parade and reception on the 17th of July 2026, is fast approaching. To make this memorial event a success Command needs your full cooperation. Due to distance we understand that some legions may not be able to support this one day event, which is sincerely disappointing. For those branches that can participate we need to know the number of your members that will be participating in the parade and attending the reception ASAP, please send the requested info to rlangevin.asts@gmail.com. This is our 100th Anniversary and our participation in this event will speak volumes to the public about our integrity and loyalty to our veterans, communities and our members. 100 Legionnaires on parade would be an historic statement, however everyone will be welcome.

The following is an overview of the Centenary Parade and Reception:

Centenary Parade: All permits have been requested and approved for the parade route and the ceremony at Queens Landing on the Halifax waterfront. We have requested a Sail Past, and a 21 Gun Salute and are waiting for approval. The parade is scheduled to step-off from the assembly area at approximately 6:00 pm.

Parade Dress: Full Legion uniform with medals and head dress. Executive Council members and Zone Commanders will also wear white gloves.

Colour Party: Full Legion uniform with medals, head dress, white gloves and white flag slings with the appropriate flags.

Parade Briefing: Will be held in the Junior Ranks at the Fleet Club at 4:30 pm sharp.

Signage: We are in the process of arranging signage to provide directions to the Fleet Club, Main Lounge and the Junior Ranks.

Parking: It is highly recommended to car pool to reduce our footprint, on the Base. Parking will be available in the upper parking lot at CFB Stadacona which can be accessed from the Gottingen Street Main Gate. Simply make a left after going through the gate and the upper parking lot will be right in front of you. The lower parking is located at the Fleet Club however, there is limited parking there. Please do not arrive before 4:00 pm due to the Base working hours. Lastly due to construction on the Base during the summer months the only access onto the Base will be from the Gottingen Street Main Gate.

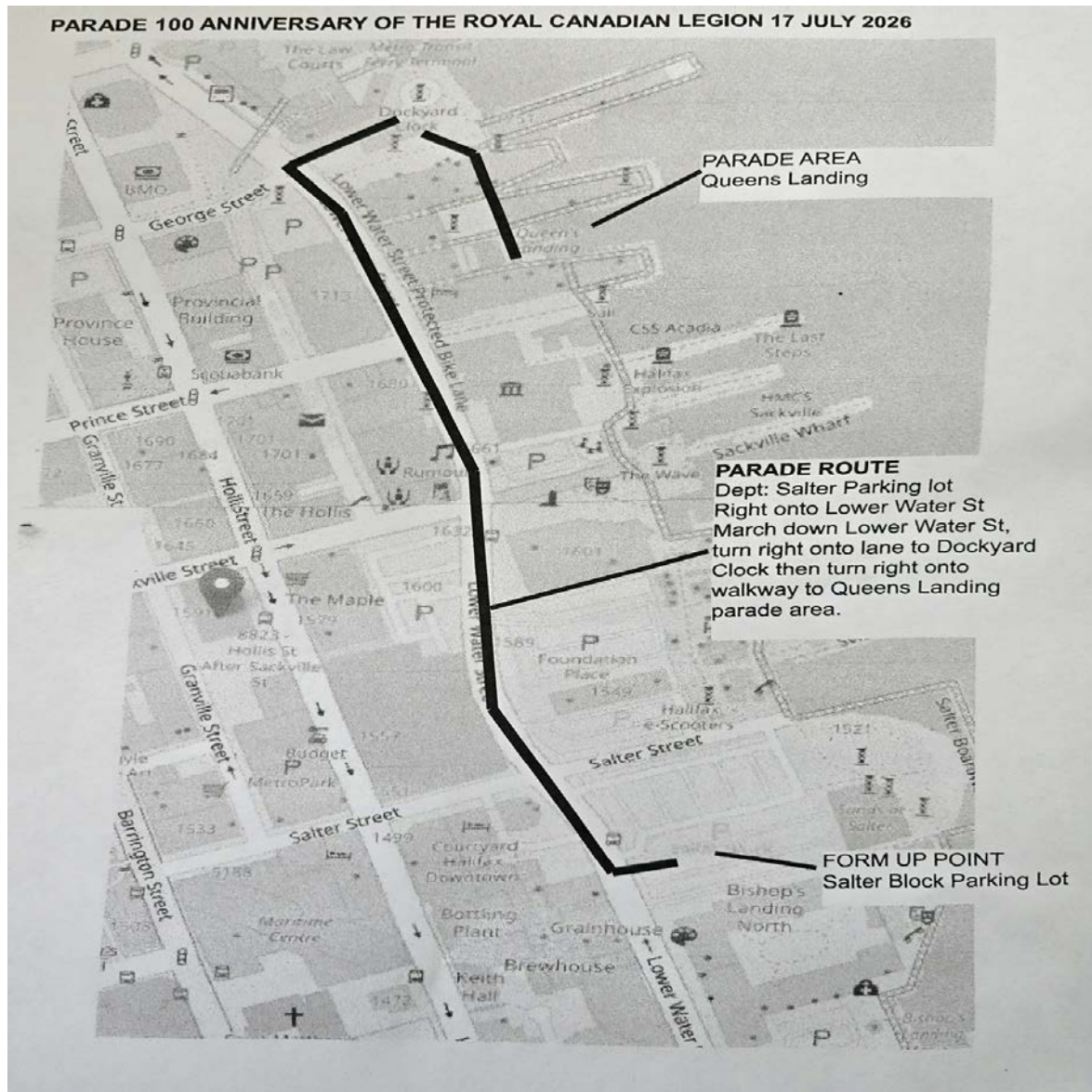
Buses: Two 54 Passenger buses have been booked, the buses will depart the Fleet Club parking lot for the parade assembly area at 5:15 sharp. They will wait for us in front of the Museum of The Atlantic on Lower Water Street which is a short distance where the parade will be dismissed to bring us back to the Fleet Club.

Reception: Will take place in the Main Lounge at the Fleet Club on the main floor, hors d'oeuvres, dessert, tea, coffee and a cash bar will be provided at the reception.
